

Welcome to Grand Rapids Ophthalmology! We look forward to seeing you soon. This packet was created to provide you with valuable information and to help answer your questions.

Please review the enclosed information. It is essential you bring the items listed below to your appointment. We realize that your time is very important. Reviewing this information prior to your appointment will save time in the office.

- **Photo ID**
- **Vision and Medical insurance cards**
- **Social Security number for all patients, including children**
- **Complete list of current medications**

Your eyes are dilated during a Complete Medical, Complete Vision and Contact Lens Examinations, as well as Cataract, Cornea, Diabetic, Glaucoma, Intraocular Lens and Retinal Evaluations; and often, for other types of appointments. Your eyes remain dilated for approximately 3-6 hours after your exam. During this time you will be unable to see clearly up close and you will experience light sensitivity. Sunglasses may be helpful. Your appointment may last 1½-2 hours. Note: Cataract and retinal evaluations may last 2½-3 hours. Please plan accordingly.

If your insurance requires a prior authorization for your visit, please take care of this before your visit. It is very important that insurance plan requirements are met to avoid unexpected out of pocket expenses. **Payment is collected at the time of service.**

If you are covered under a Workers' Compensation or a No-Fault auto claim, please be prepared with your claim number, adjustor's name, phone number and billing address for registration.

When you arrive for your appointment, you will have an opportunity to enroll in the Patient Portal. This online tool is a great way to communicate with our doctors securely, view your chart, obtain medical records, renew medications, view lab results, request glasses and contact lens prescriptions, and schedule or cancel appointments. It is to your benefit to take full advantage of all that the Patient Portal has to offer.

If the patient is under the age of eighteen, a parent or legal guardian must be present at the initial appointment. A waiver may be signed for subsequent visits.
