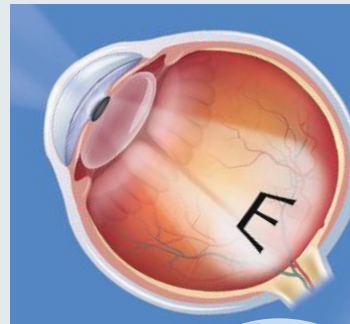
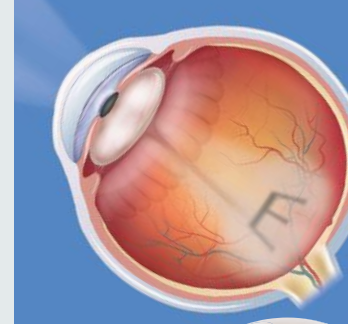

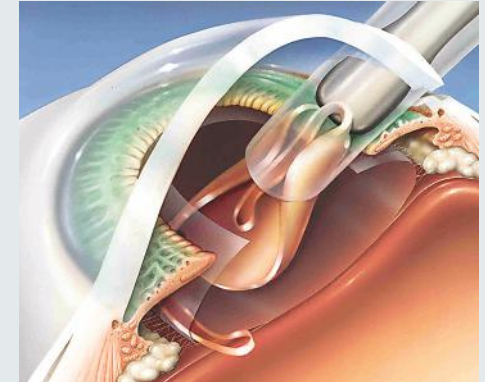
Clear Lens

A cataract is when the natural lens inside the eye becomes discolored and clouded, resulting in hazy or blurred vision at all distances. Surgery is the only way a cataract can be removed. More than 3 million cataract procedures are performed each year, making it the most common surgery performed in the United States. This outpatient procedure is performed in our CMS (Center for Medicare Services) certified and AAAHC (Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care) accredited ambulatory surgery centers.



Cataract Procedure

- A small incision is made in the eye, and the cloudy lens is removed.
- A new lens is folded and inserted through the same incision.
- With the clear lens now in place, you can enjoy your improved vision!
